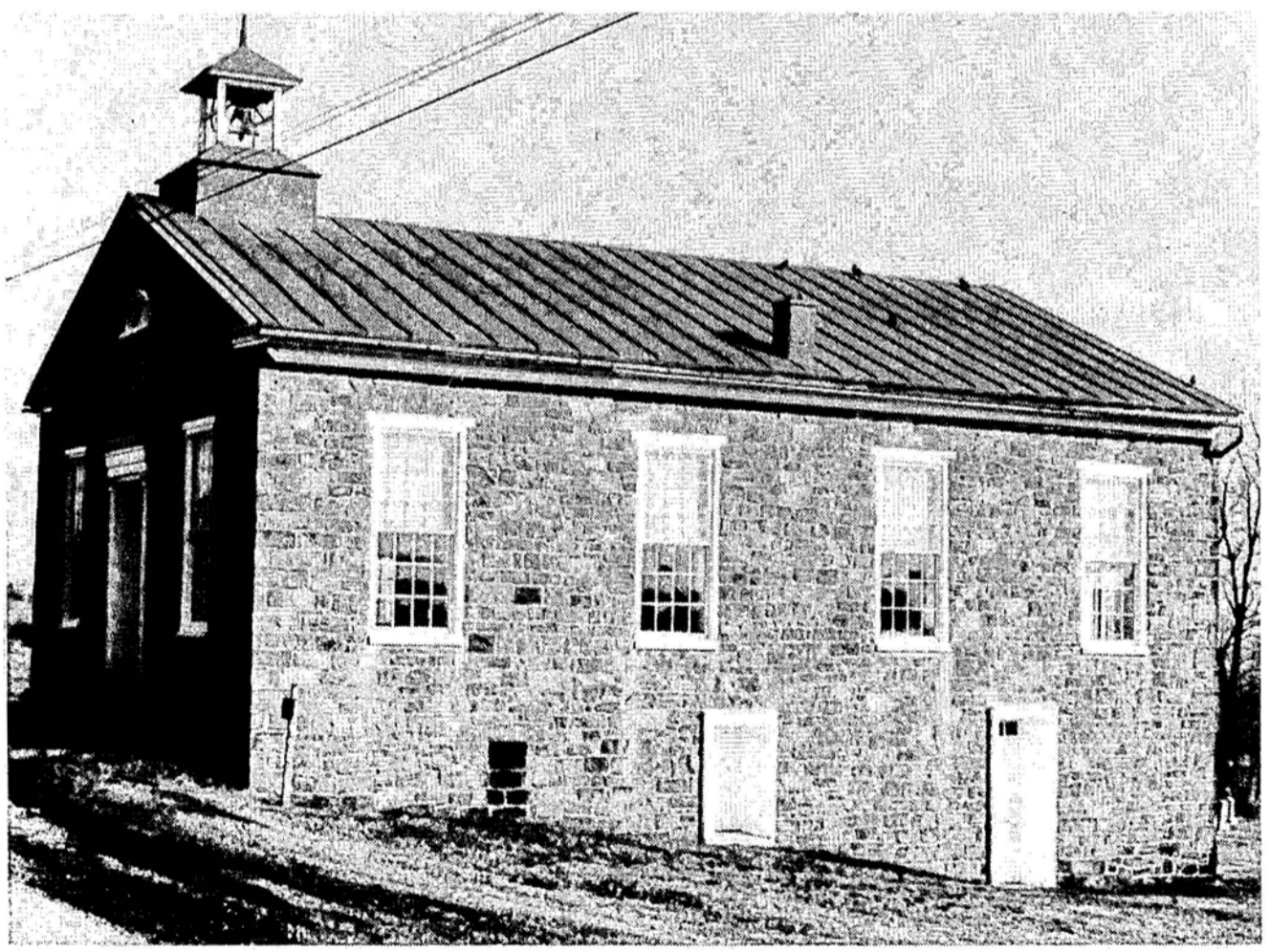

PHILIP W. OTT is Professor of Philosophy and Religion at the University of Evansville. He is a member of the South Indiana Annual Conference of The United Methodist Church. Dr. Ott has published articles on John Wesley and health in *Methodist History* (April, 1980) and *Preventive Medicine* (July, 1980).

ROBERT H. CRAIG is Assistant Professor of Social Ethics at the College of the Holy Cross, Worcester, MA. He has also taught at the University of Maine, New York Theological Seminary, National University of Costa Rica, Latin America Biblical Seminary and Bucknell University.
